
Flowchart for positive cases within extracurricular activities

Test positive (see flowchart 2) mmediately contact the representative to inform that you are positive



1. Immediately ask club members to restrict their activities or stay at home, and check their physical condition.

Persons subject to behavioral restrictions: participants in club activities Persons subject to stay at home: people who ate or drank with positive person(s), talked without a mask, traveled in the same car, etc.

If symptoms are present, visit a hospital immediately or conduct a self-test using an antigen qualitative test kit approved by the pharmaceutical affairs. (Clinics in the vicinity of the university: Oikawa Internal Medicine Clinic, Ohinata Clinic, etc.)
